ORDER OF THE ARROW TROOP REPRESENTATIVE

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Type: Appointed by the Scoutmaster
- Term: 6 months
- Reports to: Senior Patrol Leader
- Description: The Order of the Arrow representative serves as a communication link between the troop and the local Order of the Arrow lodge.
- Comments: In his troop, he serves as programmatic link to the Arrowman, adult leaders and to the Scouts who are not presently members of the Order. This position can be used for Star, Life or Eagle advancement.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Age: 13 years or older
- Rank: First Class or higher & Order of the Arrow member
- Experience: None
- Attendance: 50% over previous 6 months

GENERAL LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirttail tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.
- Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do.
- Attendance: Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on-time for meetings and activities. You must contact the Senior Patrol Leader or Scoutmaster if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. You also need to make sure that someone is ready to assume your responsibilities.

SPECIFIC LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Encourages year round and resident camping in the troop & to participate in community service projects.
- Encourages older Scout participation in high adventure activities.
- Assists with leadership training within the troop.
- Encourages Arrowmen to assume leadership positions within the troop as well as be active participants in the lodge activities and to seal their membership in the Order by becoming Brotherhood members.
