### BUGLER

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- Type: Appointed by the Senior Patrol Leader (with Scoutmaster Approval)
- Term: 6 months
- Reports to: Assistant Senior Patrol Leader
- Description: The Bugler should be able to make appropriate bugle calls, as requested, at troop activities.
- Comments: This position **cannot** be used for Eagle advancement.

#### QUALIFICATIONS

- Age: None
- Rank: None
- Experience: None
- Attendance: 50% over previous 6 months

#### GENERAL LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirttail tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.
- Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do.
- Attendance: Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on-time for meetings and activities. You must call the Senior Patrol Leader or Scoutmaster if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. You also need to make sure that someone is ready to assume your responsibilities.

#### SPECIFIC LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Makes appropriate bugle calls, as requested at all troop activities.
- Maintains the troop bugle, keeping it in good working order.
- Coordinates with the Quartermaster & Troop Committee if any maintenance/replacement is required.
